Guidance can be taken from renowned professors of IIT Madras/Annamalai University to help in lab build-up etc. The BoG further suggested that the setup for the establishment of new Branch "Biomedical Engineering" can process through the government portal "Sahyog". Besides, the proposal should be sent to Dr. Ramesh Pokhriyal Nishank, Minister for Human Resource Development, Govt. of India to request for funds for the opening of new branch "Biomedical Engineering".

The Chairman/ Vice-chairman, BoG suggested that the traditional engineering branches should have specialization, the problem solving ability in students should be encouraged and inductive reasoning approach should be promoted. The Chairman/ Vice-chairman, BoG further suggested that retired eminent professors and national level technicians should be recruited (via nomination) for the new Branch "Biomedical Engineering" and collaboration with renowned national (Government/Private) and/or international Medical University should be promoted to establish it as a top level national institute (especially for women) and Centre of Excellence. Also, there should be centralized instrumentation facility in the institute and AMC of the instruments should be done to ensure smooth functioning of the setup. Once established, the facility should also be used to generate resources for the institute.
