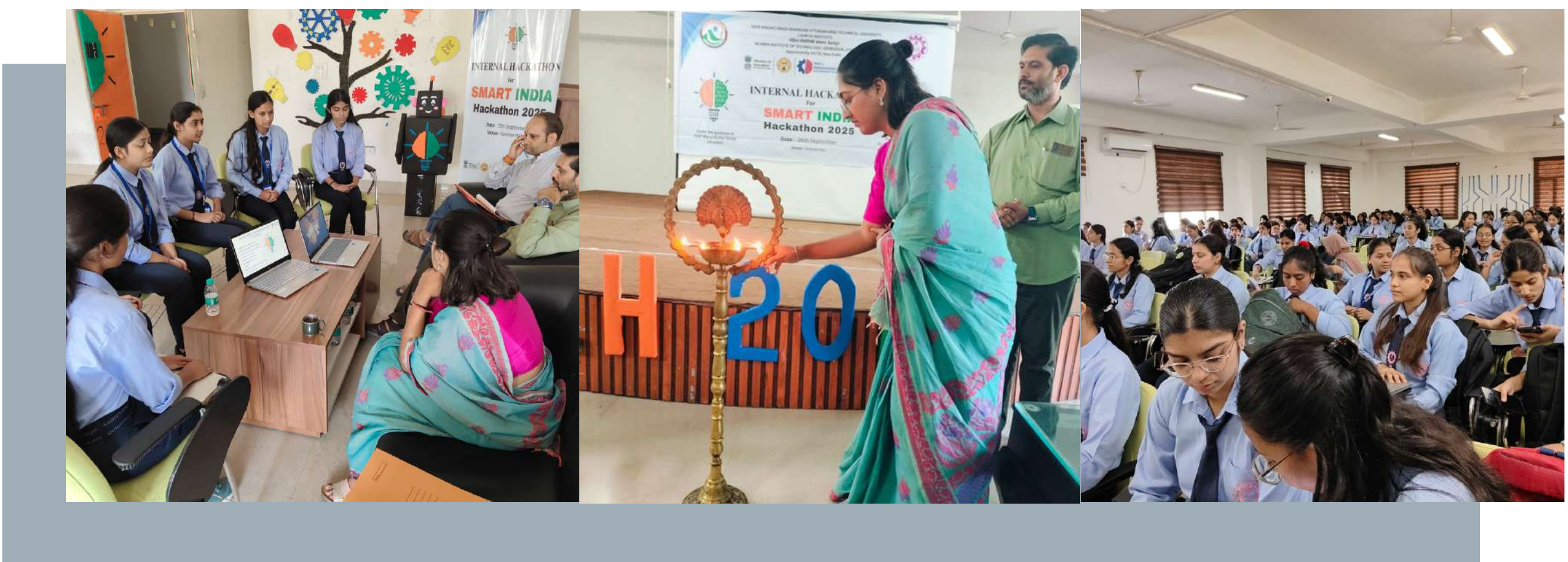

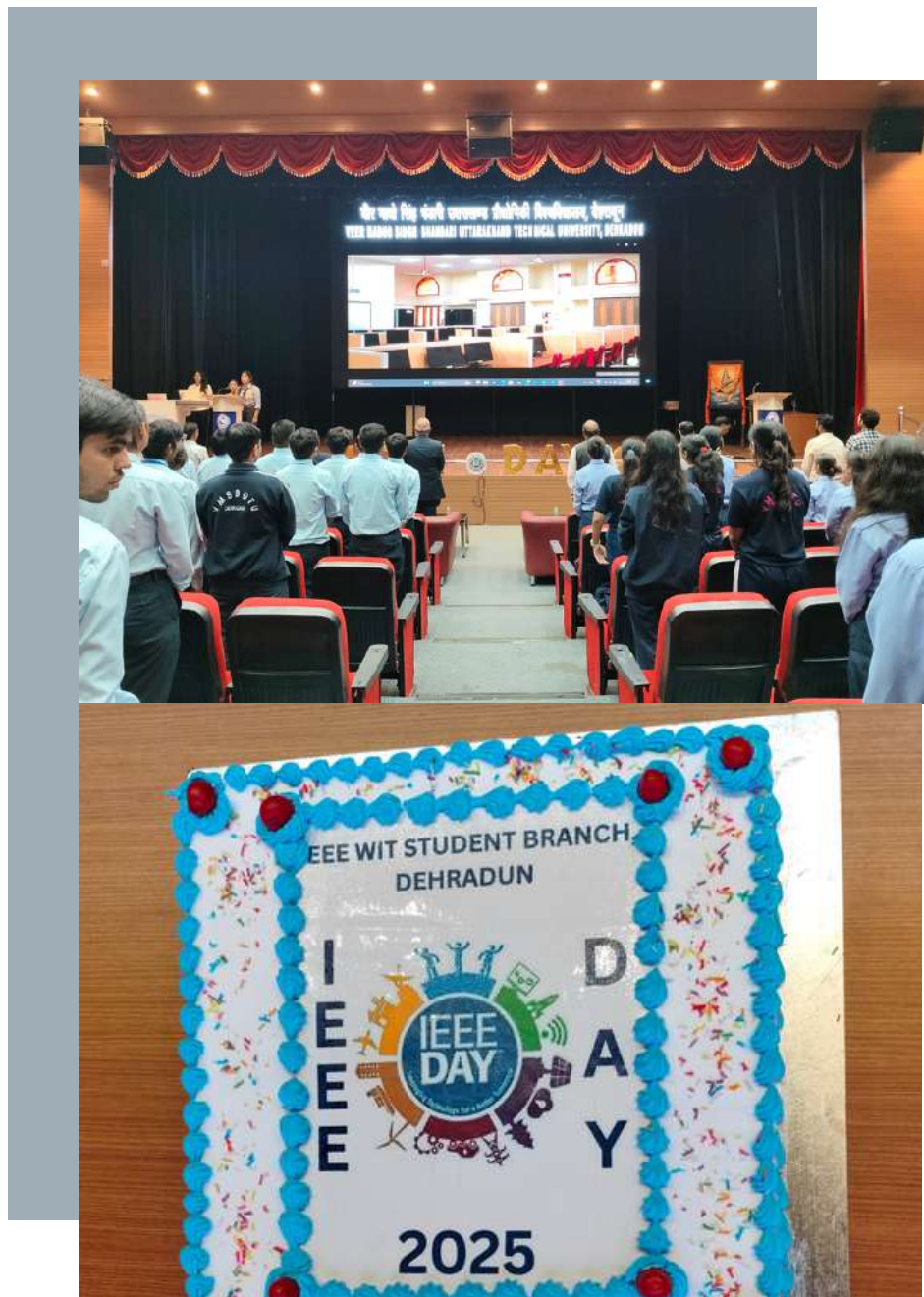
SIH WINNERS

FRESHERS



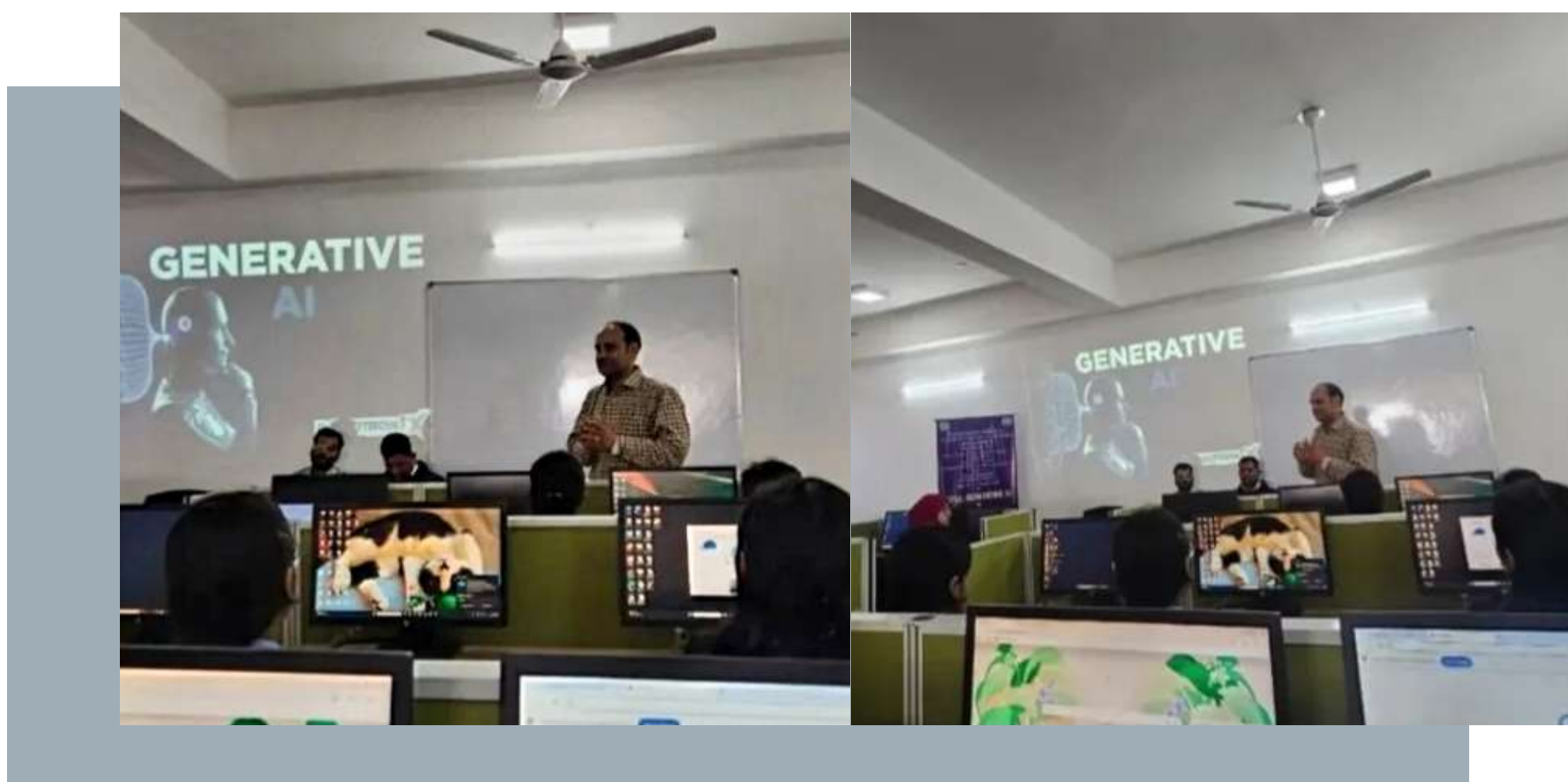
